




#### Participant Demographics: County of Residence


### **Participant Demographics: Gender Identity**







# Out-of-School Time: How many days per week (pre-Covid) were you home alone / somewhere unsupervised?






# OST: What influences how you spend your time during out-of-school hours?








#### Communications: How informed are you on current issues?








# Communications: Do you feel comfortable speaking out or sharing your opinion?




#### Where do you feel valued? (Check all that apply.)










#### Mental Health - What is your average daily level of stress?






# Mental Health - Stigma Do teens you know talk openly about mental health concerns?






Have you ever had suicidal thoughts?

Do you know anyone who has had suicidal thoughts?


# Mental Health - Access to Care Do you know where or how to find mental health care if you need it?




